TEAM CHARTER

We, the members of the Route 18 Community Partnering Team (CPT) commit to the following concepts for transportation improvements in the Route 18 corridor, Section 2F, 7E & 11H:

- Improve safety and mobility for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists in the Route 18 corridor
- Implement the design of barriers, walkways and other elements between the neighborhoods and Route 18 corridor to preserve and enhance the quality of life for residents
- Enhance the aesthetic appearance of the Route 18 corridor as the "gateway" into New Brunswick
- Improve local access and regional use of Route 18 by the design of a collector distributor roadway to separate through traffic from local traffic entering and exiting Route 18
- Enhance Boyd Park access
- Minimize and mitigate environmental and historic impacts along the corridor
- The CPT encourages the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) to expedite the study, design, and construction phases of a project to improve the operational deficiencies of the Route 1 intersection
